Registration:

Registration for the 2020-2021 school year is available the week of Nov 25. We want to give first preference to those children currently enrolled in our program. New church members, the siblings of students and our alumni will be able to register by December 2nd.

Registration forms and the fee need to be in the office on or ASAP to secure the class you want. Don't wait! After the 13th of December the class will be open to the public.

Reminder that the 2 year olds have to be 2 by September 1 to be enrolled.

The 5 day Pre-k will be filled first with children that will be turning 5 after September 1, 2019. All others will be placed on a waiting list in order of receiving their registration form and fee.

The 3 day Pre-K mixed 3 and 4's will also be filled first with 4 year olds then filled in with the older 3's.
