snow days and inclement weather policy. If Carroll County Public Schools are closed due to weather conditions, we will be closed. If schools' opening is delayed one hour, we will open our morning session one hour late. If Carroll County Schools' opening is delayed two hours, we will follow this time schedule:

AM class time will be:

PM class time will be:
1:15pm - 3:00pm

There will not be any Lunch Bunch if schools are delayed two hours. Children who stay all day will have lunch time at 12:45-1:15.

If Carroll County Public Schools are dismissed one or two hours early, we will follow the regular time schedule: 9:00-11:30 for all classes and there would be no PM class and no Lunch Bunch.

If at any time you feel conditions are too treacherous and schools have not been closed early, please do not hesitate to come and get your child. Please listen to the news cast.
