Kindergarten Registration for Carroll County is in March at the

elementary school in your attendance area. Enrollment in kindergarten is mandatory for children who will be five years of age on or before September 1.

Parents will need to present the following at the time of registration:

- Their child's birth certificate or legal document to verify their child's legal name and birth date
- Verification of residence such as a public utility bill or a lease agreement
- Specific address from which the child will be transported to school and the specific address to which the child will be transported after school
